The Canberra Aesthetic Plastic Surgery Clinic (The CAPS Clinic)

Dr Alastair Taylor established The Canberra Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (CAPS) Clinic in 1998. The clinic is now one of Australia's most comprehensive single surgeon practices. Under the CAPS Clinic umbrella is a non-surgical clinic with experienced and highly qualified Dermal Clinicians, a Skin Cancer unit with 5 Specialist GPs and a Licenced and Accredited Private Hospital.

Dr Taylor performs over 350 Aesthetic and Reconstructive cases per year and in conjunction with the Skin Cancer Doctors the hospital performs over 900 skin lesions a year.

The transition from registrar to consultant is full of unknowns. This fellowship will be a practical introduction to private practice. The successful applicant will learn consulting strategies, patient selection, operating and complication management for procedures commonly performed privately, ie breast reduction, abdominoplasty, breast augmentation, body contouring procedures, rhinoplasty and facial surgery.

360UV skin cancer clinic is staffed by 5 specialist skin cancer GPs providing monitoring and management of over 6000 patients a year, frequently referring to plastic surgery for larger and more difficult reconstructions. The fellow will be involved in this management with a dedicated operating list and learn the challenges and opportunities of owning and operating your own private hospital.

Aesthetic non-surgical is an important component of plastic surgical practice. CAPS has 3 dermal clinicians for skin care and laser/light therapies as well as 3 cosmetic injecting nurses. The fellowship includes learning cosmetic injecting techniques and patient selection.

CAPS is a model practice and is frequently visited by practice managers for education. Learn from 25 years in the Australian Healthcare System including HR and contracts, financial management, patient service, corporate branding, marketing, and interacting with Medicare and Health Funds.
